Client is receiving Holocaust Restitution Payments each month paid in Euros with the currency exchange converted to \$1899.13/month. How would this type of payment be counted in the CaFresh budget?

10. REQUESTOR'S PROPOSED ANSWER:

Per MPP 63-502.146 - Payments from government-sponsored programs, dividends, interest, royalties, and all other direct money payment from any source which can be construed to be a gain or benefit. Therefore, this type of payment would be counted as unearned income and counted in the CalFresh budget.

11. STATE POLICY RESPONSE (CFPB USE ONLY):

Per MPP 63-507(a)(18) - (a) Resources and/or income shall be excluded if specifically excluded for Food Stamp purposes by any other federal law, including but not limited to: (18) Payments made to individuals because they have been determined to be victims of Nazi persecution (P.L. 103-286, Section (1)).

Assuming the client's Holocaust Restitution Payments are being made under P.L. 103-286, Section (1), they are considered excluded resources and should not be counted in the CalFresh budget.
