9. QUESTION: (INCLUDE SCENARIO IF NEEDED FOR CLARITY):

Question 1: In a family HH that includes children under 18, if the adult chose to be excluded prior to the determination of eligibility. Does it mean that once the adult opted out, he/she cannot participate in the middle of the certification, even though the sponsor deeming requirements is not applicable anymore.

For example: In a CFAP case, the excluded (opted out) father has completed the 3 years from the date of entry and asked the CF program to add him to the ongoing case (that includes his children) in the first month following the month in which he completed the 3 years. Can the program add him, even though the request of the participation was made in the middle of the certification? In other words, the regulation states that once the individual chose to participate, they cannot opt out in the middle of the certification. What about the opposite, if the individual opted out at certification, then decided to participate before the next recertification.

10. REQUESTOR'S PROPOSED ANSWER:

Yes, the excluded eligible noncitizen can request to be added to their children case at any time during the certification, as long as they comply with the sponsor deeming rules or become exempt.
